## ***Your PCC Matters: A Digest of June's PCC Meeting***

*The formal minutes will be made available on the PCC noticeboard at the back of church once they have been agreed.*

- The PCC was pleased to welcome its new members (James Bramwell, Ishmael Gowero and Sarah Gray), as we start another church year.
- The purchase of a water butt was approved in the form of an aged oak cask (no plastic) for rainwater harvesting.
- Sandra Horner has been re-appointed to the role of Parish Safeguarding Officer, with thanks and appreciation for the great work that she does in that role.
- Plans for the new heating system are progressing well and a faculty has now been submitted. Steele Scammell Architects have been appointed as principal designers, with Wilson & Partners responsible for the heating system design.
- All the pews will need to be removed for the underfloor heating installation, raising the question of whether they should be replaced with chairs for a more flexible space. Illustrative images should be available in time for the lunch after the service on 28<sup>th</sup> June. The impact of the heating works, including discussion about the pews, will be part of our church family exploration of God's vision for St Paul's.
- We are excited to be able to participate in the 'Transforming Bromley Pledge' with many other churches in the area and have approved the purchase of 400 Mark's Gospels, illustrated with relevant local landmarks. These also feature a QR code with links to enable people to connect with different opportunities to explore the Christian faith.
